6th Asian Indoor & Martial Arts Game Athletes Selection Criteria

Entries Requirement:

1. Men/Women: Speed = 2 person

2. Men/Women: Bouldering = 2 person

3. Men/Women: Speed Relay = 2 Teams (3 persons/Team)

4. Please note that an athlete competing in more than one event should only be counted as one.

Selection Committee:

- Mr. Lee Shun Wai (Coach of Squad Team)
- ➤ Mr. Hung Ka Wai (Coach of Squad Team)
- ➤ Ms. Ng Lai Yin (Coach of Squad Team)

The nomination list will be approved by the Council of HKCMCU.

Terms of Reference:

To select athletes to represent Hong Kong, China in 6th Asian Indoor & Martial Arts Game.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Member of HKCMCU squad team.
- 2. Sport Climbing athlete/s to be chosen should possess outstanding results in international competitions:
 - i. *Ranked 1st 8th in 2017 until recent **World Championships** sanctioned by IF;
 - ii. * Ranked 1st 8th in 2017 until recent **Asian Championships** sanctioned by IF;
 - * Ranked 1st 8th in 2017 until recent multi-sports Games owned by OCA including 5th AIMAG, 18th Asian Games, 19th Asian Games;
 - iv. * Ranked 1st 8th in 2017 until recent **National Games** organized by General Administration of Sport of China including **2017 13th National Games**, **2021 14th National Games**;
 - v. Participated in 2017 until recent Olympic Games or multi-sports Games owned by ANOC including 2019
 1st ANOC World Beach Games, 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, 2024 Paris Olympic Games.
- 3. Athletes receiving HKSI Elite Training Grant with Elite C or above;
- 4. *Junior athletes who ranked 1st 8th in World / Asian Junior/Youth Championships (from 2017-2024)
- 5. HKSAR passport holder
- 6. Athletes who fulfill the criteria of the above items 1-6 could take part in the 6th Asian Indoor & Martial Arts Game selection which will be held on 18 June 2024 (Speed & Speed Relay).
- * On condition that there is a minimum of four participants in the competition(s) AND the athlete(s) ranked in the top one-third among the total number of participants.

The Selection Committee shall take into account all of the above mentioned criteria as a whole when selecting athletes to 6th Asian Indoor & Martial Arts Game.

6th Asian Indoor & Martial Arts Game Athletes Selection Criteria (con't)

Appeal Mechanism:

- 7. The athlete who disagrees with the selection result may appeal to Hong Kong, China Mountaineering and Climbing Union Limited in writing with justification within 3 days of the date of result announcement.
- 8. Appeal Panel will be formed to handle the appeal and its decision shall be final.
- 9. Members of the Appeal Panel are as follow:
 - Mr. Kwok Kam Hung Anthony (Treasurer of HKCMCU and member of the Squad Governing committee)
 - > Mr. Cheung Hei Man (Deputy General Secretary of HKCMCU and member of the Squad Governing committee)
 - Mr. Ng Ka Wai (member of the Squad Governing committee and member of the Sports Climbing committee)
 - ➤ Ms. Li Suet Man (Council Member of HKCMCU and member of the Squad Governing committee)
- 10. The final decision shall be given to the athlete in writing within 7 working days from the date of appeal.

Conditions:

- 11. The squad training attendance rate of the nominees must reach the requirement set in the rules of regulation of the HKCMCU squad.
- 12. Nominees must participate in squad ranking competitions and complied with the rules and regulation of the HKCMCU Squad.
- 13. Nominees are obligated to follow the training plan and decision made by the coaches and the Governing Committee.
