## **Aichi-Nagoya 2026 Asian Games** **Athletes Selection Criteria**

### **Entries Quota:**

1. Men/Women: Speed = MAX. 2 person
2. Men/Women: Bouldering = MAX 2 person
3. Men/Women: Lead = MAX 2 person
4. Please note that an athlete competing in more than one event should only be counted as one.

### **Selection Committee:**

- Mr. Cheung Hei Man (Vice-President of HKCMCU; Member of Governance And Selection Committees )
- Mr. Ng Ka Wai (Member of Sports Climbing Committees; Member Of Governance And Selection Committees)
- Ms. Lee Wing Shan (Vice-President of HKCMCU; Member of Governance And Selection Committees)

The nomination list will be approved by the Council of HKCMCU.

### **Terms of Reference:**

To select athletes to represent Hong Kong, China in Aichi-Nagoya 2026 Asian Games.

### **Selection Criteria**

1. Member of HKCMCU 2026-27 sport climbing squad team.
2. Sport Climbing athlete/s to be chosen should possess outstanding results in international competitions:
  - i. Athletes / Teams already qualified via the IF/AF qualification system
3. HKSAR passport holder
4. Athletes who fulfill the criteria of the above items 1-3 could take part in the Aichi-Nagoya 2026 Asian Games.

The Selection Committee shall take into account all of the above mentioned criteria as a whole when selecting athletes to Aichi-Nagoya 2026 Asian Games.

## **Appeal Mechanism:**

5. The athlete who disagrees with the selection result may appeal to Hong Kong, China Mountaineering and Climbing Union Limited in writing with justification within 3 days of the date of result announcement.
6. Appeal Panel will be formed to handle the appeal and its decision shall be final.
7. Members of the Appeal Panel are as follow:
  - Mr. Chan Hon Tong (Treasurer of HKCMCU)
  - Mr. Leung Pak Hang (Vice-President of HKCMCU)
8. The final decision shall be given to the athlete in writing within 7 working days from the date of appeal.

## **Conditions:**

9. The squad training attendance rate of the nominees must reach the requirement set in the rules of regulation of the HKCMCU squad.
10. Nominees must participate in squad ranking competitions and complied with the rules and regulation of the HKCMCU Squad.
11. Nominees are obligated to follow the training plan and decision made by the coaches and the Governing Committee.
